The Maple Leaf Trust, the charity of the Canadian community in the United Kingdom, supports the Veterans' Support Committee and the Canadian Centennial Scholarship Fund. Endorsed by the Canadian High Commissioner, the Maple Leaf Trust is supported by contributions from individuals, corporations and foundations. The Maple Leaf Trust is registered with the UK Charity Commission and contributions to it are tax-advantaged and Gift Aid eligible.

Honouring Canada's Past

The Veterans' Support Committee was established after the Second World War to help needy Canadian servicemen from both World Wars who took their discharge in the UK and who still live here. These veterans are ineligible for Canadian pensions and many find themselves in very difficult circumstances. Since its founding the Committee has provided practical and social assistance to a number of veterans and their dependents. Each family receives quarterly payments plus a bonus at Christmas, Easter and Thanksgiving and on the veteran's birthday.

Promoting Canada's Future

Since its inception in 1967, Canada's Centennial year, the Centennial Scholarship Fund has awarded over 300 scholarships of between £500 and £3,000 to outstanding students from across Canada who are already enrolled in postgraduate programmes at UK universities, colleges, institutes or conservatories.

Recipients are chosen on the basis of academic excellence, financial need and their ability to represent Canada within the UK academic community and beyond. The selection process consists of both written submissions and personal interviews. Recipients represent a breadth of academic interests and pursuits.

The Canadian Centennial Scholarships, including *The Mary Le Messurier Scholarship for the Study of History* and *The Belle Shenkman Award for the Study of Arts* are amongst the most prestigious annual scholarships for Canadians studying in the UK.
